Rules: Race will be governed by the rules as defined in the current Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS). In the event of conflict between the NOR and the SIs (or amendments thereto), the SIs as amended shall take precedence. This changes RRS 63.5(c).

J/105 Class Rules are modified by Article IX of the local J/105 Fleet 3 Article/Rules. This event is designated Level 1A. J/105 Fleet 3 Articles/Rules can be found at j105fleet3.org/rules.

Rendezvous: Prior to a competitor’s warning signal, competitors must check in at the “Race Committee Check-In” boat flying a large *yellow* flag stationed approximately 300 yards NW of the Race Committee Signal Boat. Please do not attempt to check in with the Signal Boat.

Start: Shall be between orange flag on the Signal Boat and a GREEN Tetrahedron approximately .25 nm south of GR C SR”, or alternative mark if the Signal Boat displays the “L” flag and moves to another location.

Entries: The regatta is open to all competitors who register and pay the entry fee prior to 2300 hours on Friday, 22 May 2026.

Schedule: Check in Boat on station at 0900; Warning Signal for first class at 0925.

Radio: Boats should monitor VHF 71 for courtesy communications from the Race Committee. Competitors retiring are requested to notify the Race Committee by hail or VHF.

Sailing Instructions:

Sailing Instructions shall be posted on <https://www.yachtscoring.com/emenu/50621> on or about May 18, 2026, with amendments as necessary through May 22, 2026.

Course: **All Classes will sail the same course - Annapolis Area Chart** – Start as noted above, round mark “R” – R “84A”, round mark “F” - R “2A. **Eastern Bay Chart** – round mark “N” – R”4”, round mark “Q – RN “6”, round mark “E” – GC”9”

Finish: **All classes to finish between Eastern Bay Chart Mark “D” (RN”10”) and the orange or yellow flag on the Signal Boat.** – (total of 23nm calculated with CBYRA Greenbook charts and distances)

No Time Limit: Boats finishing after 1500– passing RN"10" to starboard when the mark bears 220° magnetic., text your time and the boat in front of you to 410-310-3366.

Scoring: RRS Appendix A4, Low Point System, will apply. 15.2

Corrected times for PHRF will be calculated using PHRF Time-on-Time Random Course scoring. A boat's corrected time will be her elapsed time multiplied by: $(650 / (550 + \text{PHRF Rating}))$. A boat may not base a redress request on a race committee decision on course type. This changes RRS 60.1.

Corrected times for the ORC classes will be calculated using the appropriate ORC ratings. Corrected times for the CRCA classes will be calculated using the ORR EZ ratings. The race committee will determine the proper course type and the wind speed rating prior to scoring the race. A boat may not base a redress request on the race committee's decision of course type and wind speed band. This changes RRS 60.1.

Radio Communication:

Except in an emergency, a boat shall neither make nor receive radio communications not available to all boats. This restriction also applies to mobile phones.

Awards: 1st place trophy for 3 boats, 2nd/6, 3rd/9 & 4th/12 in each class. Awards will be presented at the post-race party as early as possible – an announcement will be made ½ hour prior to presentations.

Rhine Trophy will be awarded to the MRYC skipper with the best corrected finish using a rating system described in the Sailing Instructions.

Social: Skippers and their guests are invited to rendezvous at MRYC after the race. Live entertainment, food and drink will be featured on Saturday after the race.

Docking: A limited number of slips are available. Please inquire at <https://dockwa.com>

Note: Multihulls will need to anchor out.

PLEASE FOLLOW THE DOCK MASTER DIRECTIONS.

Rafting: The rafting off the pier T-heads is free. There is also free rafting in the Club's West basin for boats drawing four feet or less. Please follow rafting instructions from the Club patrol boat.

Tender Service: For boats wishing to anchor in or near Long Haul Creek, tender service will be available on Saturday from race finish to midnight. On Sunday, tender service will begin at 0800 and end at 1030.

Food/Drink: A la carte food options will be available on the lawn or inside the Club starting after the racing concludes. Tables for dining will be available on the lawn and inside the Club. Ice will be available for racers from arrival to departure.

Breakfast will be served Sunday 24th May 2026 – Complimentary Danish & Coffee from 0800 -0900. Breakfast sandwiches from 0830 - 0900. Full breakfast available after 0900.

Please remember that alcoholic beverages may not be brought onto nor taken from the MRYC grounds (liquor license issues).

Club Access: MRYC is committed to making visiting sailors feel safe and welcome at our Club. All Club facilities will be available to visiting sailors. The pool will be open, so bring your bathing suit. Children 12 and under must be supervised by an adult when in the pool area.

Showers/Rest Rooms: Showers and restrooms in the Club and Pool house will be open all weekend.
