Notice of Race

1.0 Rules

- 1.1 – The Nu-Core Triangle Race will be governed by [The Racing Rules of Sailing \(RRS\)](#).
- 1.2 – US Sailing Prescription to RRS 63.1 shall not apply.
- 1.3 – Class rules will apply unless waived by the Fleet Captain and posted on the Official Notice Board.
- 1.4 – The following rules will be changed. The changes will be described in full in the SIs. The SIs may also change other rules.
 - a – Race Signal AP is changed so that '1 minute' is replaced with 'not less than forty (40) minutes'.
 - b – Rule 29.2 is changed so that when a fleet has a general recall, that fleet will go to the end of the line and will then start after all scheduled fleets and any previously recalled fleets

2.0 Sailing Instructions

- 2.1 Sailing instructions will be made available online before Friday, September 4, 2026, along with a Course Sheet. The regatta website is located at www.yachtscoring.com.

3.0 Communications

- 3.1 The online official notice board is located at www.yachtscoring.com
- 3.2 Notices to competitors will be posted online on the Official Notice Board by 0900 on the day the notice, addendum, or announcement comes into effect. As a courtesy, the notices may also be posted on the front door of the Charlevoix Yacht Club, if possible.
- 3.3 On the water, the RC will make courtesy broadcasts to competitors on VHF radio channel 78.

4.0 Eligibility and Entry

- 4.1 The regatta is open to all yachts. Regatta registration is online via the Nu-Core link at the Charlevoix Yacht Club web site: www.CharlevoixYachtClub.org or at www.yachtscoring.com. Entry forms, waivers, and fees **must be completed online by 1800 hours on September 3, 2026. Registration will not be accepted after September 3, 2026.**

5.0 Fees

7.0 Divisions

- 7.1 Divisions will be established based on entries and will be announced and posted at the skippers meeting. Separate fleets may be established for Main & Jib (JAM), Spinnaker, and Multi-Hull. Divisions may also be established for similar and one-design classes. One-design divisions will be bound by their class rules. Boats that do not fit into a class (example: foiling catamaran) will be notified and may be allowed to start with a class but not permitted to affect the class standings. These boats may not be eligible for prizes.

8.0 Courses

- 8.1 The Nu-Core Triangle Race will be held in the Charlevoix end of the lake.

9.0 Ratings

- 9.1 By virtue of accepting entry into the Nu-Core Race, entrants accept the Notice of Race. Entrants agree that the Nu-Core Race Committee and the Charlevoix Yacht Club will accept PHRF certificates and have final interpretation and determination of handicaps for this event. For yachts without a valid 2026 PHRF certificate, a rating will be acquired from the US Sailing PHRF Performance Handicap listing and will be adjusted for our regional area. If a boat racing under SCHRS does not have a rating, a conversion from a Portsmouth rating will be determined.

10.0 Scoring

- 10.1 Unless otherwise specified in the Sailing Instructions; Catamarans/Non-displacement fleets will be scored using SCHRS. PHRF fleets will be scored using PHRF time-on-time.
- 10.2 The Nu-Core Triangle Race will be scored separately.

11.0 Risk Statement and Disclaimer of Liability

- 11.1 RRS 3 Decision to race applies. By participating in this event each competitor agrees and acknowledges that sailing is a potentially dangerous activity with inherent risks. These risks include but are not limited to, strong winds and rough seas, sudden changes in weather, failure of equipment, boat handling errors, poor seamanship by other boats, loss of balance on an unstable platform and fatigue resulting in increased risk of injury. Inherent in the sport of sailing is the risk of permanent, catastrophic injury or death by drowning, trauma, hypothermia, or other causes. Competitors participate in the regatta entirely at their own risk. The Charlevoix Yacht Club, organizing authority, will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with, prior to, during, or after the regatta.

12.0 Prizes

- 12.1 Nu-Core Triangle: First, second, and third place flags will be awarded in each division.

13.0 Refund Policy

- 13.1 Refund requests will be honored when submitted in writing to: CYC Nu-Core Race Committee, P.O. Box 522, Charlevoix, MI 49720, and received prior to September 3, 2026.
