**NOTICE of RACE**


**2026**

The 100-Miler is a beautiful tour of Green Bay starting from Menominee Michigan's Upper Peninsula. The marks consist of picturesque islands and navigational buoys. The course directs boats across the bay to Wisconsin's Door County, past Fish Creek, the Strawberry Islands and through the narrow passage between Nicolet Bay and tiny Horseshoe Island.

This is a fun family race scheduled for the weekend after the Chicago to Mackinac race. Menominee is a beautiful 140 nm sail from Mackinac Island heading west through the straits, past Gray's Reef and Beaver Island and heading through Death's Door with the famous bluffs of Door County providing spectacular scenery along the way.

Visiting sailors come to enjoy the green water of Green Bay, black tipped pelicans and small-town charm. They stay for the amazing MMYC hospitality and convenient amenities that come with a 250-slip marina in the center of downtown with shops, restaurants, beaches and historical buildings within walking distance of their boats.

Menominee is also a great launching point for cruising to Door County, Fayette and Bay de Noc after the race



## 100 – MILER NOTICE OF RACE M&M YACHT CLUB JULY 25, 2026

### 1. RULES

The race will be governed by the current *rules* as defined in *The Racing Rules of Sailing*.

### 2. ELIGIBILITY and ENTRY

- 2.1 The race is open to all sailboats with a valid 2026 MWPHERF Certificate of Handicap and meets current USCG regulations.
- 2.2 Registration requires submission of a 2026 MWPHERF Handicap Certificate, proof of **LIABILITY insurance with a minimum coverage of \$300,000.00** and payment of entry fee.
  - 2.2 a. Submit coverage page with liability amount.
- 2.3 Entries shall be completed online only beginning March 5, 2026, found at [YachtScoring.com](https://www.yachtscoring.com)
- 2.4 Entry will be closed at 1700 hrs. on July 24, 2026.

### 3. CLASS and FEES

- 3.1 Early registration discounts apply to completion of registration with fees paid prior to 2400 hrs., July 3, 2026.
- 3.2 **SPINNAKER CLASS:** 41.8 nm: \$130 early registration. \$160 after 2400 hrs., July 3, 2026.
- 3.3 **NON SPINNAKER CLASS:** 35.8 nm: \$100 early registration. \$130 after 2400 hrs., July 3, 2026.
- 3.4 **SMALL BOAT NON SPINNAKER CLASS-30' LOA or less:** 16.4 nm: \$80 early registration. \$110 after 2400 hrs., July 3, 2026.
- 3.5 **SMALL BOAT SPINNAKER CLASS or less:** 16.4 nm: \$80 early. \$110 after 2400 hrs., July 3, 2026.
- 3.6 Additional classes may be established for any group with three or more entries. For example, One Design or Cruiser Certificate. 35.8 nm: \$100 early. \$130 after 2400 hrs., July 3, 2026.
- 3.7 Class breaks shall be done to promote fair sailing.

### 4. SCHEDULE

- 4.1 **Sign In and Registration:** Friday July 24, 2026, 1100 to 1700 hrs. A boat representative **SHALL** check-in and register or may be subject to not being scored. Phone check-in from 1100 to 1700 hrs. may be allowed by Race Officials if they are contacted at (906) 290-4970. In-person registration is inside M & M Yacht Club.
- 4.2 **100 MILER FIRST WARNING:** 0900 hrs. July 25, 2026.
- 4.3 **Additional Events:**
  - 4.3a. Friday, July 24, 2026: **100-Miler Skipper's meeting: 1745 hrs.** Front Deck of M&M YC.
  - 4.3b. Friday, July 24, 2026: Cocktails 1730; Dinner 1800 – 2000 hrs.; Entertainment: 1800 – 2130 hrs. at the M&M Yacht Club. Register at [YachtScoring.com](https://www.yachtscoring.com)
  - 4.3c. Saturday July 25, 2026: Sailor's Picnic: Starting at 1700 hrs. or adjusted to accommodate the finishers.
  - 4.3d. Saturday July 25, 2026: Results and Awards when available. Or Sunday July 26, 2026, 1000 hrs. as an Alternative.

Offshore activities are on the waters of the bay of Green Bay.

**7. SCORING**

Final places will be determined by corrected time from fastest to slowest. Corrected time will be calculated using the Time-on-Time rating from MWPHRF, subject to protests and/or penalties decided by the Judge as necessary.

**8. PRIZES**

Brag flags will be awarded to the top 3 finishers in each class. Overall winners will be awarded a brag flag and will be inscribed on perpetual trophies at the M&M Yacht Club.
