1 RULES

- 1.1 The event is governed by the Racing Rules of Sailing.

2 SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

- 2.1 Sailing Instructions will be available at www.Yachtscore.com no later than Thursday, August 27th. Simply type Mason's Island Regatta in the search box.

3 COMMUNICATIONS

- 3.1 The online Official Notice Board is located above in 2.1.
3.2 All boats shall carry a VHF radio capable of communication on 01A (1001).

4 ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

- 4.1 The event is open to ORC, One Design and PHRF Classes.
Non-Spinnaker boats are welcome and will have separate classes. We will make an effort to start a one-design class as long as there are four or more entries including double-handed class.
4.2 Competitors may enter the event by referencing 2.1 above. Entries close Thursday August 27th at 6pm.

5 FEES

- 5.1 Entry Fee is \$50 per boat. Party Tickets are \$20 in advance, \$25 at the door.

6 SCHEDULE

- 6.1 First Warning will be at 11:00 am, Saturday, August 29th, certain One Design Classes will be at 1:30 pm. See Sailing Instructions for details.

7 VENUE(s)

- 7.1 Two Racing Circles are planned.
7.2 Circle Alpha is located South of Groton Long Point, CT.
7.3 Circle Bravo is located near White Rock which is located South of Latimer Point, Stonington, CT

8 COURSES

- 8.1 Courses will consist of Windward/ Leeward or Point to Point; Class dependent.

9 AWARDS

- 9.1 Awards will be presented to the top 3 boats in each class at the Post Race Party, Mason's Island Yacht Club at 5pm, Saturday.

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Mason's Island Regatta is the second leg of the Island Cup 2026 with the other legs being Ram Island YC on August 22nd and Fisher's Island YC on September 5th.
