1. RULES

- 1.1. The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in the current Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS) and the International Laser Class Association (ILCA) rules.
- 1.2. The Organizing Authorities: Corinthian Yacht Club of Cape May (CYCCM) and Local ILCA District 10 and MAYRA.
- 1.3. RRS 40 will be deleted and replaced with: "Competitors shall wear personal flotation devices, except briefly while changing clothing or personal equipment. Wet suits and dry suits are not personal flotation devices." Note that Code Flag "Y" will not be displayed.

2. ELIGIBILITY

- 2.1. ILCA 6 class and 7 Class boats competitors who are current members of the ILCA NA or their national Laser Class Association, may enter by completing registration in Yacht Score at https://www.yachtscore.com/event_registration_email/50899 Competitors must enter their valid class association ID number in YS and also list their home yacht Club.
- 2.2. All Boats, equipment and, sails must meet current class rules.
- 2.3. Competitors must be capable of racing offshore and safely handling strong waves and tidal currents particularly in the Cape May Inlet.

3. SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

- 3.1. The Sailing Instructions will be available at YachtScore.com by Friday August 7

4. Communications

- 4.1. **Prior to Sunday August 09** all Official notifications will be posted on Yacht Score.
- 4.2. Official notices posted after Saturday August 08 will be posed on the official Notice Board on the porch of the CYCCM Sailing Building (AKA Wally World)
- 4.3. Signals ashore will be flown from the Club mark boat Ovah on the club docks. If Ovah is not available signals will be posted from the signal boat Cohort.

5. RISK

- 5.1. Disclaimer of Liability
- 5.2. The races will take place off shore, conditions permitting. Competitors participate in the regatta entirely at their own risk – See RRS Rule 4, Decision to Race. The Corinthian Yacht Club of Cape May will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during or after the regatta.

6. Registration and Fees

- 6.1. The entry fee is \$40 USD, Payment may be made by credit card online at yachtscoring.com.
- 6.2. This event, taking small single hand boats offshore, requires substantial planning and resources to ensure a safe and successful regatta. Consequently cooperation with timely completion of the YS registration process is appreciated and essential.
- 6.3. Only Online Registration will be permitted, Registration and payment must be completed by Friday August 7 at noon.
- 6.4. A Signed waiver must be completed in YS.
- 6.5. Under no circumstance will walk in registration or late registration be accepted.
- 6.6. Registered competitors must check in before close of the Final Check in the Club house main ball room on Sunday August 9 at 0930.
- 6.7. The entry fee includes breakfast refreshments, on the water snacks and water, after race refreshments (Pizza), and Awards.
- 6.8. Final check in will close at 0930 prior to the skipper's meeting.

7. SCHEDULE OF EVENTS

- 7.1. **Friday August 7**, SI posted on or before COB
- 7.2. **Saturday August 8**, no later than 1800 Hrs., the RC shall make a final determination regarding: weather and safety conditions, to Race or, Race in Cape May Harbor. If no race is able to be sailed based on weather forecasts and anticipated conditions, registrants will receive refunds less a small PayPal administrative fee.
- 7.3. **One race shall constitute a regatta**
- 7.4. **Sunday August 9**
 - 7.4.1. 0800 – 0930 Check in and Breakfast refreshments
 - 7.4.2. 0945 Skippers Meeting
 - 7.4.3. 1030 Harbor Signal
 - 7.4.4. 1104 Low Tide

- 7.4.5. 1130 First warning signal, up to 5 races to follow.
- 7.4.6. 1754 High Tide
- 7.4.7. Awards and pizza will follow ASAP after the last race.

8. Courses and Venue

- 8.1. Course configurations will be described in the SI. Generally, courses will be windward/leeward with dropped marks and offset weather marks and downwind gate, with reaching finish.
- 8.2. 6.3 Conditions permitting racing will be held in the ocean off Cape May, either on the East Course off Wildwood Crest Beaches, approximately 1.2 miles NE of the Cape May jetty or, the West Course off Cape May Beaches approximately 1 mile West of the jetty. Alternatively, Cape May Harbor may be utilized if unsafe or poor racing conditions offshore dictate. Final course location will be announced at the Competitors meeting.
- 8.3. 6.3 Tidal Currents going in/ out and the inlet may be unfavorable and require boats to be towed. Skippers are strongly recommended to carry a tow line of approximately 25 feet to attach to club launch tow bridges.

9. Penalty System

- 9.1. 6.4 Appendix V parts V 1 and V2 shall be in effect.

10. SCORING

- 10.1. The Low Point Scoring System for a Regatta, Appendix A2, will be used except as modified below.
- 10.2. There shall be no throw outs.

11. AWARDS

- 11.1. ILCA 6 Class and 7 Class - First through fourth place and, Highest finishing MAYRA Shall be MAYRA Champion in each class.

12. FURTHER INFORMATION

- 12.1.1. Parking is no longer available in the parking lot previously used by the yacht club. All parking will be on Delaware Avenue. CYCCM volunteers will be available to assist with unloading and loading near the boat yard.
- 12.1.2. Please adhere to the speed limit on Delaware Avenue.
- 12.1.3. CYCCM is located adjacent to the USCG Training Center near the large red and white water tower. From the NJ Parkway follow Rte 109 over the canal bridge then over the small bridge, stay in the left lane at the Tuna Club and follow the signs towards the USCG.
