

NOTICE OF RACE

HAMPTON ONE-DESIGN NATIONAL CHAMPIONSHIP 2026

Hampton One Design Class Racing Association
Deltaville, Virginia - August 7, 8 & 9, 2026

- WHERE:** Registration and launch facilities at the Fishing Bay Yacht Club, Deltaville, Virginia. Races will be sailed on the Piankatant River and/or Chesapeake Bay.
- WHEN:** Check-in for this regatta will be from 0900-1000 on Friday, August 08th, 2026. The competitors' meeting will be held at 1100 on that day. Nine races are scheduled. Three races are planned on Friday, four on Saturday, and two on Sunday, but this may change at the discretion of the PRO for weather or other reasons:
Friday August 7th – 1st Warning 1330 (Harbor Start 1200)
Saturday August 8th – 1st Warning 1030 (Harbor Start 0900)
Sunday August 9th – 1st Warning 1030 (Harbor Start 0900)
No races will be started after 1430, Sunday, August 9. Four races must be completed to constitute a series. There will be a throw-out if six races are completed.
- RULES:** The regatta will be governed by the Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS), together with the prescriptions of US Sailing, the Hampton One Design class rules and the Sailing Instructions.
- CLASSES:** All Hampton One Design owners that are current members of the HOD Class are eligible to enter. The Hampton One Design National Executive Committee will make final decisions on eligibility, including any waiver of eligibility requirements.
- EQUIPMENT:** Competitors are reminded that the class rules require each boat to carry a paddle, an anchor, 50 feet of anchor line, and life jackets for the skipper and crew. This equipment must be available for verification by class measurers between 0900 and 1100 Friday morning. The Sailing Instructions **will** also specify the use of VHF radio is required for all competitors, and the Race Committee may use the VHF radio to communicate important information to competitors.
- AWARDS:** Trophies will be awarded on Sunday following the last race of the day. Trophies shall be given to helmsmen and crew for the first five places. There will be participation awards for all competitors. The J.W. Hurst perpetual trophy will be awarded to the highest placing novice. Novice is defined as a competitor that has not won a CBYRA sanctioned event in the Hampton Class. The Regatta Chairman will post a list of eligible competitors for the Hurst Trophy prior to the first race. The William J. Daugherty Memorial Trophy will be awarded to the best crew of the year. The T. Lane Stokes Cup will be awarded to the Hampton One Design sailor (skipper or crew) who: exhibits exemplary sportsmanship, actively participates in Hampton One Design regattas, and actively promotes the Hampton One Design Class. The Charles H. McCoy, Jr. Hampton One Design High Point Trophy will be awarded to the skipper with the most points as outlined in the Sea Chest document.
- WAIVER:** All sailors must sign waiver online. If under age 18, print, have parent/guardian sign and bring to check-in..
- ENTRY FEE:** Competitors must pre-register online; registration materials and instructions available at: <https://yachtscoring.com/emenu/50917> The registration fee is \$250 if paid by August 1. The late registration fee after August 1 is \$275. Registration includes 3 days of racing and dinner on Saturday night. Additional guest tickets for the Saturday dinners may be purchased via the registration form online (preferable), or at check-in on Friday for \$25.
