NOTICE OF RACE

1. Rules

1.1 The Regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in The Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS), class rules, the rules of WFPHRF, this Notice of Race, and by the Sailing Instructions.

2. Eligibility

2.1 The event is open to any self-righting, enclosed cabin sailboat and multi-hull that conforms to class rules and holds a valid WFPHRF certificate

3. Entries and Fees

3.1 The Entry fee for this event is \$100 or \$90 with proof of current US Sailing membership.

3.2 Entries and payment should be made via the Yacht Scoring site. Shortcut link: SummersetRegatta.com/rsvp. If assistance is required, please contact organizing authorities.

3.3 All entries must hold a valid current WFPHRF certificate.

3.4 Entry deadline is 1700 hrs., Tuesday, September 28, 2026.

4. Divisions

4.1 Divisions will be PHRF Spinnaker, PHRF Non-spinnaker, PHRF True Cruising, and PHRF Multi-hull.

4.2 The Race Committee may combine or divide Divisions based upon the number of entries. A boat will not be placed in another division without consultation with that registrant. The race committee may combine divisions for starts based on the number of boats in each division.

5. Races and Courses

5.1 The races on Saturday will be buoy races in the vicinity of the San Carlos Light (SC). The race committee will attempt to run up to five (5) races.

5.2 The race on Sunday will be a distance race with the start and finish in the vicinity of the San Carlos Light (SC).

5.3 GPS Coordinates for some or all of the marks to be used in the Sunday race will be published in the Sailing Instructions. Yachts are encouraged to have a GPS.

6. Sailing Instructions

Sailing Instructions will be available at the Skipper and Crew Meeting and posted on the Summerset Regatta Official Notice Board, SummersetRegatta.com/rsvp prior to Saturday's racing.

7. Official Notice Board

The Yacht Scoring website SummersetRegatta.com/rsvp is the official site for ALL notifications. It is each boat's responsibility to check for changes on the Official Notice Board.

8. Scoring

8.1 The low point scoring system will be used with no races excluded. This changes RRS Appendix A2.1.

9. Prizes

9.1 Overall trophies will be awarded in the Sunday Distance Race, and in each Division combining all Saturday and Sunday races.

9.2 Divisions will be awarded prizes for First, Second, and Third Places.

10. Safety

10.1 All boats shall carry a working VHF radio capable of transmitting and receiving on channel 72 and weather channels.

10.2 A boat retiring shall notify the signal boat as soon as possible.

11. Dockage & Accommodations
